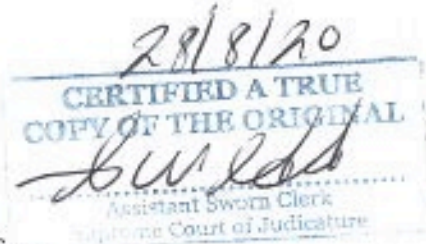

1. an Extension of Time to further hold the above named suspect in further custody

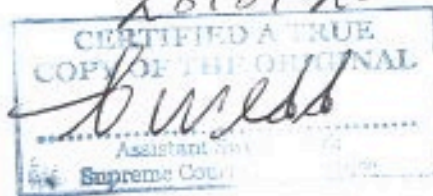
was heard on this 28th day of August, 2020, at the High Court, Georgetown.
